TEST ONE DROP & STOP Diabetic Ketoacidosis

A simple, inexpensive finger stick or urine test could save a life.

Warning Signs of Type 1 DIABETES:

- excessive thirst
- frequent urination/bedwetting
- · increased appetite
- abdominal pain
- irritability/grouchiness
- headaches/vision changes
- itchy skin/genitals/yeast
- sudden weight loss
- nausea/vomiting*
- fruity-scented breath*
- lethargy/drowsiness/fatique*
- · labored and/or rapid breathing*
- confusion/unconsciousness*

Type 1 Diabetes is often confused with common illnesses. Don't assume! Ask your doctor to **TEST ONE DROP** of blood or urine to check for high glucose levels and stop DKA before life-threatening complications occur!
